PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

Pursuant to the press release issued by the Prime Minister's Office, dated 20th January 2022, regarding the measures to be put in place until January 30, 2022 as decided by the National Covid-19 Taskforce following the risk assessment and considering the highly infectious nature of the Omicron variant, the Dzongkhag Covid-19 Taskforce hereby notifies the general public of Trashi Yangtse the following with immediate effect:

Activities allowed:

1. All offices will remain open.
2. Schools and educational institutions that can function in containment mode will be open.
3. All shops and businesses can open until 9 PM.
4. Funeral services shall be limited to family members only with a maximum of 20 heads
5. Intra-Dzongkhag movement.
6. Rimdros and loches will have to be confined to only family members with the services of monks from within the Gewogs only.

Activities not allowed:

1. Mass gathering or celebrations, including religious congregations, birthdays, promotions and other festive events.
2. No inter-Dzongkhag movements allowed, unless it is unavoidable, which will be subject to approval after ensuring negative antigen test results.
3. No sporting activities are permitted.
4. Entertainment centres like night club, karaoke, snooker, pubs and discotheques are not allowed.

Further, in view of the rising number of Covid-19 positive cases in the country detected from the quarantine facilities as well as in the community, the Dzongkhag Covid-19 Taskforce would like to reiterate that:

1. Use of facemask in all public places is MANDATORY whether while in group/crowd or alone.
2. Offices/schools/business entities must ensure that customers without facemask are not entertained and entry denied.
3. Use of Druk Trace is mandatory for entry into all public places and customers who do not use Druk Trace are not entertained.
4. Avoid crowding in public places and maintain physical distance at all times.
5. Offices/Schools/Business entities to make provisions for hand washing facilities or hand sanitizers and enforce its use at all times.
